

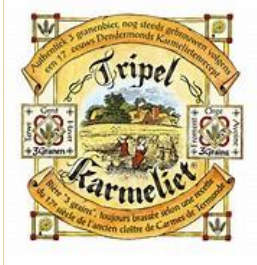
# VINI DRAUGHT BEER LIST



## THE BRUERY MISCHIEF (8.5% ABV)

12 OZ/\$6

Mischief is a hoppy Belgian-style golden ale. This golden ale is dry-hopped with American hops to add a layer of complexity and mystery to its fruity, dry Belgian-style character. Citrus and resin combine with ripe melon, pear and slight peppery spice in a precariously effervescent mixture.



## TRIPEL KARMELIET (8.4% ABV)

12 OZ/\$6

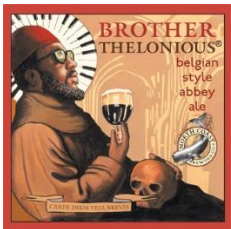
Tripel Karmeliet has a complex gold to bronze color, with a creamy head. This is partly due to the cereals but also to the limited use of Styrian hops, the abundant herbs and fruity aroma (banana and vanilla) of the used yeast. This beer has not only the lightness and freshness of wheat, but also the creaminess of oats, and it also has a spicy, lemony dryness almost reminiscent of quinine.



## REISSDORF KOLSCH (4.8% ABV)

7 OZ/ \$3 or 14 OZ/\$6

Reissdorf Kolsch is the beer specialty from Cologne with a tradition starting in 1894. A Kolsch with a pleasant, full-bodied, and uniquely light and sweet taste. Brewed for the adepts who prefer something special.



## NORTH COAST BROTHER THELONIOUS ALE (9.4% ABV)

12 OZ/\$6

This ale is full of depth and complexity: the nose features heady aromas of dried fruits, ripe figs, then rich warm banana, clove, caramel and molasses, while the palate features rich, warm flavors of toffee, brown sugar, molasses & toasted dark bread. Surprisingly, the finish is dry with lingering light warmth, making you ready for your next sip.



## CORONADO BREWING CO. ISLANDER IPA (7.0% ABV)

14 OZ/\$6

Islander IPA pours a golden amber color with a thick, fluffy white head. The aroma is that of fresh, tropical hops mixed with pine. The flavor follows the smell with resinous piney hop flavors and fresh apricot. There is also a noticeable caramel malt presence, though the hop is the main character in this story.



## PORT BREWING CO. SHARK ATTACK DOUBLE RED ALE (5.5 % ABV) 14 OZ/\$6

This double red ale, Shark Attack, is a classic west coast-style Imperial Red Ale brewed with Crystal Malts, Centennial and Cascade Hops. A smooth malty beer with a generous hop character, Shark Attack finishes out with sweet caramel hints and spicy hops.
